More and more fleets are turning to natural gas as an alternative to gasoline-powered vehicles for the significant operating, economic and environmental advantages that using natural gas as a transportation fuel afford.

“Natural gas as a transportation fuel is extremely safe, but its unique properties require specialized training to properly operate and maintain natural gas vehicles and fueling stations,” says Leo Thomason, Executive Director and lead instructor at NGVi. “I always stress the importance of safety to anyone considering using natural gas.
